What Personal data does Friends of Broadhurst Park Community Group (FoBPCG) collect?

The personal data we routinely collect includes members, committee members and volunteer's names, email addresses, telephone numbers, and addresses. We also collect names, email addresses and telephone numbers (and address if they prefer to receive information by post) of those who wish to join our mailing list.

How do we obtain your personal data?

We obtain personal data directly from members, committee members and volunteers, and those wishing to join our mailing list. We do not gather personal data from third parties.

What is the legal basis for FoBPCG collecting your personal data?

FoBPCG collects personal data for which you have given your specific consent. We collect only the personal data that is necessary for the purposes our legitimate interests as a 'Friends of' Community Group.

As consent is the legal basis on which we have gained your personal data, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time and ask us to end your membership/remove you from our mailing list, and delete your personal data. You can make this request by emailing us at:
